Declaration on "conflict minerals"

In July 2010, the Dodd-frank Wall Street reform and the Consumer Protection Act (Wall Street reform Act) were put into effect. This reform imposes documentation and publicity obligations on companies using certain materials to ensure that no conflict material is used in their products. This directive was created to protect miners from exploitation and undignified working conditions in the dismantling of certain metals ("conflict minerals"). The following countries ("Covered Countries") are protected by this: the Democratic Republic of Congo, Angola, Burundi, the Central African Republic, the Republic of Congo, Rwanda, South Sudan, Tanzania, Uganda and Zambia. The exact details can be read in section 1502 in HR 4173.

The ATE Antriebstechnik und Entwicklungs GmbH & Co. KG, according to the best of our knowledge and current knowledge, ensures that the products delivered to your customers have not been contained with the metals gold, tungsten and tantalum.

The conflict mineral tin is only added in very small quantities for the production of our stator and rotor components, by using tin-containing solders. For the solders used, we have proof of origin from our suppliers up to the smelting stage.

As the CMRT (Conflict Minerals Reporting Template) has been established for the reporting of conflict minerals, this has been prepared and can be downloaded from www.ate-system.de.
